# Lovatts \$100K Cash Splash Competition Terms and Conditions of Entry

## **General**

- 1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of the Terms and Conditions of Entry. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 2. To the extent of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any other reference to this competition, these Terms and Conditions prevail.

#### Who can enter

- 3. Subject to the clauses below, entry is open to all residents of Australia and New Zealand who have fulfilled the requirements set out below ('Eligible Entrants'). Entrants must be over the age of 16, as of the date of entry.
- 4. Employees, and their immediate families, of the Promoter, associated agencies and companies, contractors or individuals are not eligible to enter this competition.

  Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, defacto spouse, child or step child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step parent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step brother, step sister or 1st cousin.
- 5. Any entrant who is under the age of 18, as of the date of entry, must obtain the prior permission of their legal parent or guardian over the age of 18 to enter. The parent or guardian may be called to verify their consent and may be required to sign a release at the discretion of the Promoter. The release may also require the entrant's parent or guardian to accept responsibility for the acts and forbearances of the entrant. The release must be completed with the full name, address and telephone number of the entrant's parent or guardian. Failure to provide such proof, particulars or releases will immediately invalidate the entrant's entitlement to any prize, subject to State and Territory legislation.

## **How to enter**

- 7. To enter Eligible Entrants must, during the Promotional Period (defined below): purchase a Lovatts participating puzzle magazine title (Eligible Product Purchase), solve the competition puzzle, and complete an entry form at www.lovattspuzzles.com/cashsplash.

- 9. To be eligible in the draw to win, entrants must solve the competition puzzle (as highlighted in the issue) and enter the solution, as well as the entry code shown in the participating title. Entrants must provide the correct solution to the "Lovatts \$100K Cash Splash Promotion" to be entered in the draw. Only entries submitted with the correct answer will be accepted. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into with any entrants or any other person. All entries become the property of the Promoter.
- 10. Entrants must provide their name, address, postcode, telephone number and, if available, email address. Entries must provide contact details on request to be eligible to win. ## **Number of Entries permitted**

11. One entry per Eligible Product Purchase. All entrants must retain their original receipts, magazine issue, or Lovatts subscriber record to validate proof of purchase during the promotional period. Such evidence must, on request by the Promoter, be provided to the reasonable satisfaction of the Promoter, to demonstrate that the entrant has complied with these Terms and Conditions. Any entrant found to be sharing any receipt or other proof to demonstrate Proof of Purchase with any other entrant, whether or not related in any way, will have all entries invalidated and will not be able to claim a prize. If such an entrant is awarded a prize and then found to have breached this clause, the entrant must immediately return any awarded prize to the Promoter. The Promoter has sole discretion to determine if this clause has been breached by any entrant. The Promoter reserves the right to request whatever documentation it deems necessary to confirm if the entrant has breached this clause. An entrant must provide any requested documentation to the Promoter upon request. The Promoter may conduct an immediate redraw if the first drawn entrant is unable to satisfy this clause.

# Open, Close, Draw and Publish dates

- 12. The competition commences on 30/04/2021 at 10:00 AM (AEST) and closes 27/01/2022 at 11:59 PM (AEDT) ('Promotional Period'). All times noted in these Terms and Conditions are local times, based on the location of the Promoter. If any draw date falls on a public holiday, as defined in the state of the Promoter, that draw will be conducted on the next business day. Entries must be received by the Promoter prior to the competition close date and time.
- 13. Subject to clause 18, the winner will be the first valid entry drawn at the Promoter's Premises at 100-102 Terrigal Esplanade, Terrigal, NSW 2260 on **01/02/2022** at **10:00 AM** (**AEDT**). The winner will be notified by email or phone on the day of the draw, and their

Arrangements will be made for the winner to be present at the envelope draw on 01/03/22. If the winner is not able to be present, a proxy can be appointed.

- 14. On the envelope draw date, the winner, or their proxy, will select one (1) envelope from a pool of one hundred (100) on 01/03/22 at 11:00 AM (AEDT). If the winner or their proxy are not present, the winner will be contacted by phone and the Promoter will be the winner's proxy to select envelopes on their behalf. There will be one envelope with the prize of AU\$100,000 noted in it. The other envelopes will have AU\$5,000 noted in each. access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a winner or Entrant; or (f) use of a prize.
